

RESEARCH FELLOW, WILLIAM J. HUGHES CENTER FOR PUBLIC POLICY

ELIGIBILITY:

Tenured faculty members at the level of Associate Professor or above are eligible to serve as Research Fellow for the William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy if they possess the following qualifications:

- Expertise in political science or related disciplines.
- Commitment to the mission of the Hughes Center
- Demonstrated effectiveness in policy analysis and communication

APPOINTMENT AND TERM:

The Research Fellow will be appointed by the Provost who will receive nominations from a screening committee composed of the Chief Executive Officer for External Affairs & Institutional Research, Director of the Hughes Center, a Dean designated by the Provost, and two faculty designated by the President of the Faculty Senate. Such nominations will be based on a letter of application which addresses the eligibility requirements and CV. The selected Fellow will move to a private office in the Hughes Center suite, and will be guaranteed the right to return to her/his office after the Fellowship term.

COMPENSATION:

Compensation shall be 8 TCH per year, with no summer responsibilities. Additional summer compensation may be awarded for specific summer assignments.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Research & Policy Analysis

1. Perform policy and data set analyses, including literature reviews.
2. Complete a minimum of one applied research project per academic year on public policy issues important to New Jersey. Such projects will align themselves with the annual priorities designated by the Hughes Center Steering Committee. Resulting papers will be disseminated through the Hughes Center to appropriate policy makers and constituents.

Outreach to Faculty and Community

3. Engage faculty/students to participate in the activities of the Center, including the research activities of the Hughes Center.

4. Engage the public and decision-makers in policy issues that include opinion polls, election-related debates, and /or other formats as appropriate.

Reporting Requirements:

5. Products of the Research Fellow's efforts will be submitted to the Director of the Hughes Center.

6. As appropriate, the Research Fellow will contribute to annual reports of the research/policy analysis activities of the Hughes Center.
