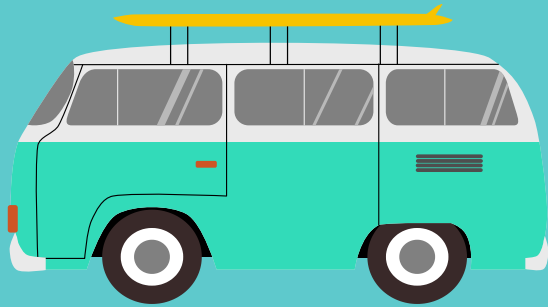

On June 10th, the NJ Assembly & Senate Higher Education Committees held a joint meeting in Trenton to hear testimony from invited guests on the findings of [New Jersey City University's Fiscal & Governance Monitoring Report and Fiscal Accountability Plan](#). Though NJCU is on track to meet goals and benchmarks set by the state-appointed fiscal monitor, the university is far from financial independence.
