FULL YEAR PILOT OF VIRTUAL PRC **MEETINGS**

The Provost Office and SFT have agreed to a fullyear pilot to assess the efficacy of virtual meeting options for PRCs who vote to pilot these options in 2024-2025. This optional expansion will allow PRCs to meet virtually throughout the year, building on last years' experience where PRCs could meet virtually over winter break only. Full details here.

NEW RANGE ADJUSTMENT PROGRAM FOR NTTPS

In alignment with the new 2023-2027 Statewide Master Agreement and our 2023 local Agreement for Non-Tenure Track Positions, NTTPs will now receive longer multi-vear contracts after their initial 5-year probationary period. Also, NTTPs have a new range adjustment program, which is in addition to existing opportunities for advancement, similar to those that exist for tenuretrack faculty. MOA here.
