

Memorandum of Understanding

Evaluation of Preceptorial Advising, Spring 2008

The parties acknowledge that problems have arisen with respect to the process of preceptor evaluation during the Spring 2008 administration, such that in some cases the validity of the results may not be trustworthy. Nonetheless, other results may be valid, and employees may wish to use the results to document their effectiveness as preceptors.

Consequently the parties agree that:

1. Employees who would otherwise be expected to include the results of this preceptor evaluation in their evaluation files will not be required to do so, and their decision not to do so will not be judged adversely during any review; and
2. Employees who wish to do so may include the results of this evaluation in their evaluation files.
3. The College will consult with the SFT regarding the resolution of the technical problems.
